The new system will replace the current Medicaid claims management system (Omnicaid) and the NM Medicaid Provider Web Portal.

A key feature of the new Turquoise Claims system is single sign-on access. From one point of entry on the <u>YES.NM.GOV</u> website, you'll be able to access the Provider Enrollment system, the Learning Management System (LMS), and the new claims management system—all with one login.

For The Love of Consistency: Managed Care Claims Submissions Unchanged

There are no changes to managed care (MC) paper claims submissions or claims submitted directly through a Managed Care Organization's portal. Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) files will continue to be submitted via clearinghouses, just as they are today. If you submit EDI claims, please look for a separate email with more details.
