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SUBJECT: NAME CHANGE TO THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FOR ALIENS (EMSA) PROGRAM TITLE

This supplement is issued to inform New Mexico Medicaid providers of a name change related to the Emergency Medical Services for Aliens (EMSA) program.

In accordance with guidance from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), effective January 1, 2022, the EMSA program will be known as the Emergency Medical Services for Non-Citizens (EMSNC) program. The change is being applied to the program rule, NMAC 8.325.10 and all applicable forms, see list of forms below, effective January 1, 2022.
