**Interested Parties:** 

The New Mexico Health Care Authority (HCA) Medical Assistance Division (MAD) is providing notice on plans to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) request to comply with the Medicare Hospital Outpatient Prospective Payment System (OPPS) and Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) Payment System final rule 42 CFR 440.90 amendment to assure coverage for clinic services outside of the "four walls" of Indian Health Service (IHS)/Tribal clinics.

The estimated total financial impact is \$0 in federal funds for FFY 25 and \$0 in federal funds for FFY 26 as this submission addresses administrative changes to reflect the permanent continuation of a flexibility that has existed for IHS and Tribal clinics and reflects the movement of New Mexico's approved State Plan clinic benefit to CMS' standardized preprint.
