V. BACKGROUND SUMMARY

The New Mexico Health Care Authority (HCA), through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD), has filed an emergency amendment to the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC) rule 8.310.2, Health Care Professional Services, General Benefit, to address the high rates of maternal mortality and ensure the health and welfare of vulnerable women of New Mexico.

Section 9-8-6 NMSA 1978, authorizes the Department Secretary to promulgate rules and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the duties of the Department and its divisions.


VII. EFFECTIVE DATE
