# Proclamation

*WHEREAS, New Mexico salutes those parents who support their children and encourages those who have difficulty meeting, or are failing to meet their child support obligations to reach out for assistance; and*

*WHEREAS, the employability of all New Mexicans is paramount to ensuring that parents have the adequate resources and opportunities needed for sustainable economic stability to provide for their children and their families; and*

*WHEREAS, New Mexico's Child Support staff are dedicated advocates for improving the lives of children and families through employer engagement and constituent outreach; and,*

*WHEREAS, ensuring that children receive the financial support they deserve involves working partnerships between city, county, state and federal agencies, parents, legislators, judges, healthcare professionals, advocacy groups, employers, and many others; and*

*WHEREAS, through these partnerships, New Mexico collected \$130.3 million in child support during State Fiscal Year 2022, 60 percent of which was collected through wage withholdings from employed parents; and*

*WHEREAS, it is vital for all New Mexicans to work together to foster a better understanding of the importance of fulfilling financial responsibilities to our children.*

*NOW THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, do hereby proclaim August 2022 as:*
