## **V. BACKGROUND SUMMARY**

The United States Department of Health and Human Services requires the New Mexico Health Care Authority meet certain Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) work participation requirements. To assist in meeting these requirements, federal regulations (45 CFR 261.40) allow New Mexico to decrease its work participation rate percentage by the number of percentage points that the FY 2024 caseload fell in comparison to the FY 2005 caseload. This is termed the TANF Caseload Reduction Credit.
