## MEDICAID POWERS NEW MEXICO HEALTH CARE

## MEDICAID MEMBER IMPACTS

**At least 88,530 New Mexicans permanently lose Medicaid coverage**

- **Nearly 14,900** active Medicaid non-citizens will likely be disenrolled permanently beginning October 2026
- **Approx. 89,000** expansion adults likely permanently disenrolled due to work requirements beginning January 2027

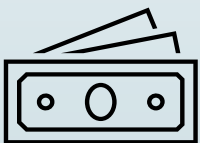
**5,648** could lose at least 1 month of coverage due to limits on retroactive coverage starting Jan. 2027

**220,014** subject to new co-pays and increased administrative



## MEDICAID FISCAL IMPACTS

Loss of **\$8.5** billion in federal funding to provider payments 2028-2037



## MEDICAID PROVIDER IMPACTS

**50+** safety net providers lose critical funding

**6-8 hospitals** could close within 18-24 months



## MEDICAID SYSTEMS IMPACTS

18 months and \$35 million needed to support integrated Medicaid & SNAP IT systems changes including Call Center and YES.NM.GOV
