

NEW MEXICO CCBHCs



The New Mexico Health Care Authority (HCA) launched the Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) Demonstration on January 1, 2025, affirming the state's commitment to expanding access to high-quality mental health and substance use treatment services.



WHAT IS A CCBHC

CCBHCs are specially designated clinics that provide a range of outpatient mental health, substance use disorder, and primary care screening services, serving all ages. CCBHCs are required to serve anyone who requests care for mental health or substance use regardless of their insurance status, ability to pay, or place of residence.



WHAT SERVICES ARE OFFERED

CCBHCs provide the following services either directly or by contracting with partner organizations, with an emphasis on providing 24/7 behavioral health crisis care, use of evidence-based practices, care coordination to navigate the provision of whole-person care among health care providers, social services and other involved systems, and integration with physical health care. Core CCBHC services include:

- + 24/7 Crisis Services
- + Outpatient Mental Health and Substance Use Services
- + Person- and Family-Centered Treatment Planning
- + Community-Based Mental Health Care for Veterans
- + Peer Family Support and Counselor Services
- + Targeted Case Management
- + Outpatient Primary Care Screening and Monitoring
- + Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services
- + Screening, Diagnosis and Risk Assessment


