The New Mexico Health Care Authority (HCA), Medical Assistance Division (MAD) is providing notice on plans for reimbursement for Traditional Health Care Practices (THCP) through Tribal facilities and Indian Health Service (IHS).

The effective date for this service is October 1, 2025. The HCA received approval from the Centers for Medicare/Medicaid (CMS) October 16, 2024, to implement the THCP service under the 1115 demonstration waiver. This is a five-year approval ending December 31, 2029, unless extended.
