Enclosed, please find documents related to New Mexico State Plan Amendment (SPA) 25-0005
Medicaid Recovery Audit Contractor (RAC) Program.

New Mexico's two-year exception to discontinue the Recovery Audit Contractor (RAC) Program
is expiring on September 30, 2025 and New Mexico is requesting to resume RAC for the
purpose of identifying underpayments and overpayments effective October 1, 2025.

The estimated total financial impact is \$(122,584,000) in federal funds for FFY 2026 and \$(117,925,500)
in federal funds for FFY2027.

The HCA followed a process that included public notification, tribal notification, and web
posting. Documentation of these activities is attached, along with the transmittal form and
supporting SPA materials.
