Key Information	<p>Learn about the Medicaid Justice Re-entry project to reach into New Mexico prisons and jails up to 90 days prior to a Medicaid member's release and coordinate health care services as they transition back to the community.</p> <p>Mandatory services for youth include targeted case management and diagnostic and screening assessments.</p> <p>Mandatory services for adults include care management, 30 days of prescription medication in hand, and Medication Assisted Treatment (when medically necessary).</p> <hr/> <p>Progress to date:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Justice Re-entry Program approved by CMS July 2024● Implementation plan submitted to CMS Nov. 2024● Consolidated Appropriations Act federal requirements for youth re-entry services begin Jan. 1, 2025● Tentative phase-in of adult services: summer 2025
